establish long term partnerships." The objective is to "grow species of trees currently not found on campus, demonstrate tree care and growth characteristics and encourage self-learning through signage & brochures."

Initially, the cost for this project is estimated at \$30,100. Itemized, this cost will include:

- *Design development* - \$1,800 (plans)
- Hardscape installation— \$4,500 (DG pathways, benches, sign posts, protective fencing, mulching)
- Irrigation development— \$3,500 (Quick Coupler, hose, rotor system)

- Plant material purchase— \$10,800 (48 species X \$75 X 3 individual trees)
- Labor/Equipment— \$4,200 (student/staff/equipment rental)
- Signage— &1,800 ( 48 X 2 X \$20)
- Brochure— \$3,500 (Design and printing)

Long term costs of running the arboretum were also factored in, and included :

- Administration—\$1,200 (Arboretum Manager)
- Tree Care— \$1,500 (Pruning, replacement, staking)

- Site Care— \$2,200 (Trail refurbishment, mulching, weed/rodent management)
- Labor— ? (2 part-time students)
- Brochure & Signage \$250
- For a total of approximately \$5,000— \$7,000.
