Purposes of Street Tree Seminar, Inc.

- a. To bring together professional people in a permanent organization to accumulate, discuss disseminate information concerning the problems of Street Tree Maintenance Management in both rural and urban area within Southern California or where similar conditions prevail.
- b. To encourage and provide direction to students of Ornamental Horticulture and Urban Forestry through the issuance of scholarships, intern programs, etc.
- c. To sponsor an annual educational meeting in addition to monthly meetings devoted to the exchange and presentation of information of interest and value to street tree managers and arboricultural professionals.

Meetings

Seminar meetings are normally held during the last week of the month (July is dark – there is no meeting). An annual educational meeting, Western Tree Management Symposium is held each January.

Committees

Street Tree Seminar has many committees whose primary purpose are to assist members in dealing with the many problems confronting the professional street tree manager in this period of tight budgets and increasing demands for service. New members are given the opportunity to work on the committee(s) of their choice.

Membership Classifications and Dues

- a. **Active membership** shall consist of management and supervisory personnel of public tree agencies or those related to street tree management. This membership category shall include educators and individual consultants. Active members can vote and shall enjoy the privilege of holding such office for which they may be elected. Active and Associated membership dues are \$30.00 per year payable on or before August 1st of each year.
- b. **Sustaining membership** shall consist of persons or firms whose business is related to street tree management. Sustaining membership dues are \$60.00 per year for up to two representatives and \$30.00 per year for each additional representative payable on or before August 1st of each year.
- c. **Honorary membership** shall consist of persons who by virtue of their outstanding contributions and efforts have greatly enhanced the objectives of Street Tree Seminar. Honorary members are not eligible to vote or hold office.
- d. **Life membership.** Those active members who have reached retirement age in their respective agencies shall be eligible for Life membership recognition.
